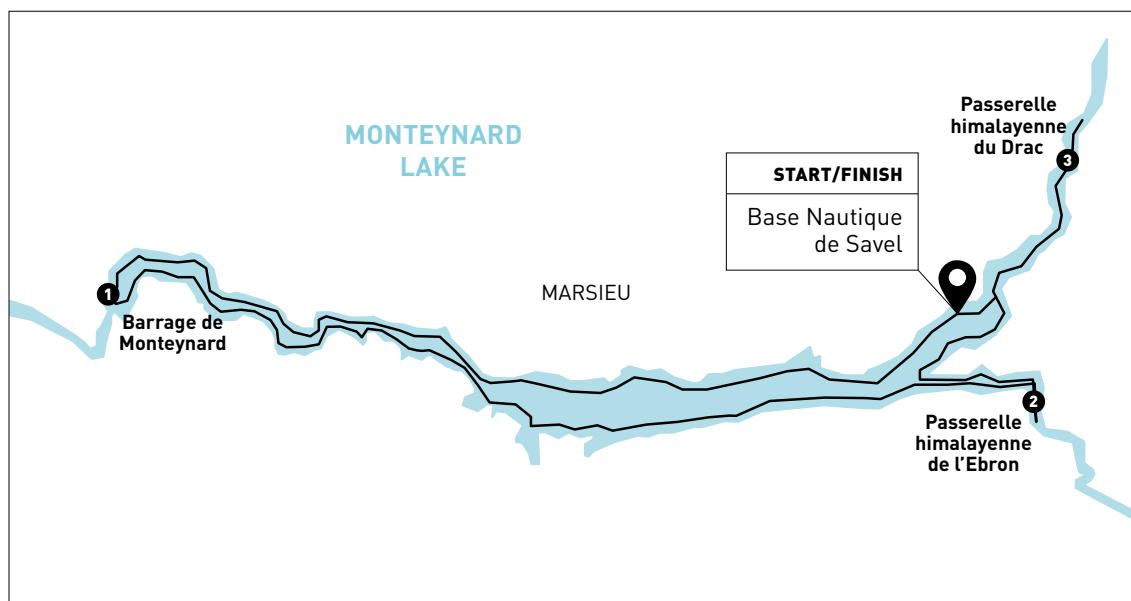

Located one hour away in the south of Grenoble, 15 minutes away from La Mure on the Matheysine plateau, the Monteynard lake is a 10-km long and 300-m wide artificial lake, fuelled by two rivers, Drac and Ebron. It is situated in an exceptional natural spot, between Trièves and Matheysine. In this world apart and along the route, you will enjoy a spectacular and always changing mountain scenery – the turquoise water takes you far away...The Himalayan footbridges are unique and stunning from the coxed fours.

PROVISIONAL PLANNING

8.45 AM Departure from the beach to the dam on the right bank, then return via the left bank. The crews will row on the river Ebron to the 1st Himalayan footbridge and join the river Drac to the 2nd Himalayan footbridge and return to the beach after a 30-km tour. Possibility of returning without going to the 2nd. Himalayan footbridge (a 28-km tour).
