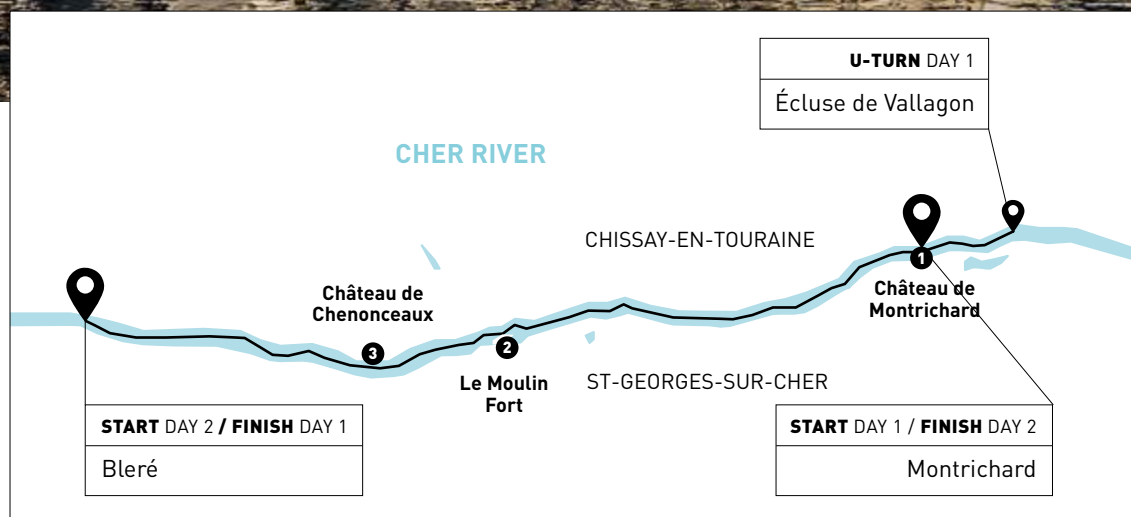

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Rowing down the Cher will take you on a tour down the pastoral shores of the Cher valley, laden with castles, old houses and mills. Navigating on peaceful waters, you will be enchanted passing under the arches of Chenonceaux castle, an unforgettable moment when leaving and coming back! Some additional surprises wait for you, like the Moulin Fort, a watermill from the 16<sup>th</sup> century, needle dams built in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. You will meet the period-costumed rowers of the "Yole de Loire" association. Accompanying persons can follow the route by bike on the "le Cher à vélo" trail.

## PROVISIONAL PLANNING

### DAY 1

**9.00 AM-5.00 PM** 22 km, beach of Montrichard-Vallagon - passing under the Chenonceaux-Bléré castle.

Picnic in Chisseaux with local specialities, dinner and musical atmosphere, accommodation alongside the Cher at the campsite in Bléré (rental accommodation or tent).

### DAY 2

**8.00 AM-12.30 PM** 20 km, Bléré - passing under the Chenonceaux castle, beach of Montrichard.

Lunch at the end of the tour at the restaurant of Parc-Plage in Montrichard in a festive atmosphere (Banda Jean).
